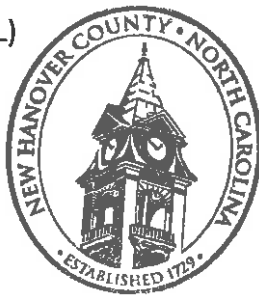



**NEW HANOVER COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
PROCLAMATION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY**


- Section 1:** Pursuant to New Hanover County Code Chapter 17, Article III, Section 17.71 and Section 17.72, and North Carolina General Statutes Chapter 166A and Article 36A, Chapter 14, the New Hanover County Board of Commissioners has determined that a State of Emergency as defined in the New Hanover County Code Section 17.71 exists throughout New Hanover County.
- Section 2:** Therefore, the New Hanover County Board of Commissioners proclaims the existence of a State of Emergency in New Hanover County.
- Section 3:** The New Hanover County Board of Commissioners hereby orders all county-wide law enforcement officers, employees and emergency management personnel to cooperate in the enforcement and implementation of the provisions of the county/municipal emergency ordinances.
- Section 4:** Emergency protective measures shall be announced as necessary.
- Section 5:** This proclamation shall become effective at 11:00 a.m.
