

**NEW HANOVER COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
PROCLAMATION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY**

- Section 1:** Pursuant to New Hanover County Code Chapter 17, Article III, Section 17.71 and Section 17.72, and North Carolina General Statutes Chapter 166A, Article 1A, 166A-19.22, the New Hanover County Board of Commissioners has determined that a State of Emergency as defined in the New Hanover County Code Section 17.71 exists throughout New Hanover County.
- Section 2:** Therefore, the New Hanover County Board of Commissioners proclaims the existence of a State of Emergency in New Hanover County.
- Section 3:** The New Hanover County Board of Commissioners hereby orders all county-wide law enforcement officers, employees and emergency management personnel to cooperate in the enforcement and implementation of the provisions of the county/municipal emergency ordinances.
- Section 4:** Emergency protective measures shall be announced as necessary.
- Section 5:** This proclamation shall become effective Tuesday, September 3rd at 5:00 p.m.
